- build understanding of GoPNG long term strategies and implications for policy, budgets, annual plans and aid development programs
- establish networks, links, relationships across GoPNG agencies, AusAID, managing contractors and other development partners
- raise awareness of major private sector/NGO initiatives that will impact on government policy and programs.
